Rules and Regulations

Date: 2nd & 3rd August, 2024

Grade: Primary (1-4)

1. Solo Dance:

- Type: Dance form can be Classical or Western or Folk
- Judgement criteria: Rhythm, Choreography, Synchronization and Overall Performance
- Songs must be brought in pen drives only, and must be submitted 30 minutes prior to the starting of the event. Keep a backup file
- **Duration: 3+1 (After Warning) minutes only**
For Preliminary Round – 1 +1 Min.

2. Solo Song:

- Type: Song can be classical, semi-classical, western or film.
- The lyrics must be memorised
- Songs can be of any language
- Neither accompanist nor karaoke music is allowed.
- Sruti box is not allowed
- Judgement criteria: **Rhythm, Voice, Melody and Overall Performance.**
 - **Duration: Preliminary round: 1+1 min**
Final Round: 2+1 (After warning) minutes only

3. Clay Modelling:

- Clay of different colours must be brought by the students
- Pre-set models or stencils are not allowed
- Can make only 3- D models for the given topic
- **Time duration maximum 1 hour.**
- No Preliminary Round
- **Topic: Your Favourite Food**

4. Fancy Dress:

- Face covering masks are not allowed
- Participants are **not allowed to speak** on the stage.
- Duration: **One minute** only on stage
- **Judgement criteria: Presentation, Creativity, Costumes and Overall Performance**
- No Preliminary Round
- No theme

Rules and Regulations

Date: 2nd & 3rd August, 2024

Grade: UP (5,6,7) & HS (8,9)

1. Solo Dance:

- Type: Dance form can be Classical or Western or Folk
- Judgement criteria: Rhythm, Choreography, Synchronization and Overall Performance
- Songs must be brought in pen drives only, and must be submitted 30 minutes prior to the starting of the event. Keep a backup file
- **Duration: 3+1 (After Warning) minutes only**
- **For Preliminary Round – 1 +1 Min.**

2. Extempore:

- Topics will be given at the venue
- Participants will be given 10 minutes for preparation
- **Time for the presentation of speech will be 3+1 (After warning) minutes**
- **For Preliminary Round – 1 +1 Min.**
- Criteria for Evaluation: Spontaneity, Ability to express thoughts, Fluency in language, Body Language, Confidence

3. Elocution:

- **Duration: 3+1 (After warning) minutes only**
- **For Preliminary Round – 1+1 Min.**
- Judgement criteria: Presentation of Topics, Logical Sequence, Voice Modulation, Language, Expression and Overall Performance
- **Topic:**
HS: The Role of Empathetic Leadership in the AI Era
UP: Ways in which AI will transform the World

4. Mehendi:

- Team consists of two members
- One member's palms will be the canvas
- We request the participants to bring all the necessary materials
- Design and the theme should be explained to the Judges
- **Duration: 1 hour 30 mins.**
- Judgement Criteria: Choice of Design, Cleanliness, Overall Execution, Creativity and Perfection
- No preliminary round

5. Solo Song:

- Type: Song can be classical, semi-classical, western or film.
- The lyrics must be memorised
- Songs can be of any language
- Neither accompanist nor karaoke music is allowed.
- Sruti box is not allowed

• Judgement criteria: **Rhythm, Voice, Melody and Overall Performance.**

- **Duration: Preliminary round: 1+1 min**
Final Round: 2+1 (After warning) minutes only

6. Rangoli:

- Team consists of two members
- **Duration: 1 hr 30 mins only**
- The students are required to bring rangoli powder
Only rangoli colours can be used for making rangoli
- The students will not be allowed to refer any printed /drawn picture of rangoli during competition.
- The rangoli should be relevant to the topic given. Judgement criteria: Creativity, Choice of Design, Colour Combination, Cleanliness and Overall Effectiveness
- No preliminary round
- **Theme: Nature Beauty**
- Size: 3x3ft

7. Face Painting:

- Team consists of two members
- One member's face will be the canvas
- We request the participants to bring all the necessary materials
- Design and the theme should be explained to the Judges
- **Duration: 1 hour.**
- Judgement Criteria: Choice of Design, Cleanliness, Overall Execution, Creativity and Perfection
- No preliminary round
- **Theme: - Tiger Day**

8. Best Out of Waste:

- Students can bring waste materials such as bottles, newspapers, plastic, or electronic waste
- The materials must be safe and not pose any health risks to self or other participants.
- The work will be disqualified if the materials used are brand new, so use only from waste product or 2nd hand item.
- **Time duration will be 1 hour.**
- No preliminary round
- **No theme**

9. Vegetable Carving:

- The students are required to bring their own working tools, fruits and vegetables
- Fruits and vegetables required to be used as the main material for carving
- Pre -slicing, carving or preparation of vegetables are not allowed.
- **Time duration - maximum -1hour 30 min.**
- No preliminary round
- **Theme: Birds**

Group Event:

1. Debate: (HS)

Each House can select a team. Four students in a team

- **Topic: Children Under 18 and Social Media**

- Two students for the motion, Two students against the motion

- 3 Minutes for debate (Main context)

1 minute for rebuttal (Round)

- No participants are supposed to refer the paper and speak (Marks will be deducted if found so)
- Maximum 1 team can participate from a house
- First team's rebuttal round will happen in the end, after other teams have finished their 3+1 minutes.
- Rebuttal should be written during the debate of other participants. (Marks will be given for presence of mind)
- Order of teams will be given on the spot before the competition begins.
- Students participating in debate are supposed to stay back in their respective venue until they get the permission from event managers.
- Judgement Criteria: The rhetoric, expression, accuracy, logical sequence, style and overall performance

2. Quiz: (HS)

A team consists of three members

- It is a house wise competition, so one team will participate from each house
- The questions cover literature, culture, sports, general knowledge, science and current events

3. Collage: (MS & HS)

Team consists of two members

- **Duration: 1 hr only**

- **Topic: Influences of Technology**

- Only Chart paper will be provided

- Participants have to bring all the necessary materials

- Only newspaper and magazine cuttings will be allowed

- No marble paper and other printed paper will be allowed (Plain colour paper can be used)

- Only paper should be used for collage work

- Sketch/Marker pens of any one colour can be used

- Tracing is NOT allowed

- Use of scissors is not allowed

- Pre-cut pieces can be used for the collage

- Participants have to clean their working area

- Judgement Criteria: **Creativity, Imagination, Integration, Originality, Quality and the Communicative function.**

4. Group Song: (MS & HS)

Type: Any Language

- Maximum number of participants: 10
- **Duration: 4+1 (After warning) minutes only**
- Use of recorded music (Floppy, CD, Cassette, Inbuilt keyboard tracks, any digital storage device etc.) is not allowed
- Entries: One team each both in UP and HS.
- Judgement criteria: **Rhythm, Voice, Melody and Overall Performance.**

5. Group Dance: (MS & HS)

Type: Any Dance forms.

- The song must be submitted on a pen drive, 30 minutes prior to the starting of the event. (Keep a backup file)
- No re-starts will be permitted unless requested by the judges
- **Judgement criteria:**
a) **Presentation of step description, and the expressed emotion** b) **Flow and co-ordination of choreographed moves,** c) **Originality of steps or step combinations,** d) **Suitability of steps for music/rhythm selected and visual appeal**
- **Duration: 5+1 (After warning) minutes only**
- Maximum number of participants: 10
- HS and UP joined group is not allowed
- Entries: One team each both in UP and HS

6. Mime: (MS & HS)

Medium shall be English only

- **Any social theme** can be used
- **Maximum number of Participants: 8**
- **Duration: 3+1 (After warning) minutes including arrangements**
- Entries: One team each both in UP and HS
- Use of recorded music (Floppy, CD, Cassette, any digital storage device etc.) and recorded dialogue is not allowed
- Only Students are allowed to play background music
- **Judgement criteria: Presentation, Creativity, Action, Theme, Language and Overall Performance.**
