## **Rules:**

## Artista:

- Only drawing sheets will be provided
- High School and Middle School students shall use watercolours, oils or acrylics.
- Time duration for painting competition is 1 hour and 15 minutes (75 minutes)
- Lower Primary School shall use sketch pens and crayons.
- Spot registration is available (starts at 8:00 am)
- Registration fee: HS- Rs.200, UP- Rs.150, LP- Rs. 100
- 8:45 am to 9:45 am [for LP] 09:00 am to 12:00 pm [UP +HS]



## Vegetable carving:

- Only one team can participate from each school.
- Each team should consist of 2 students.
- The total time allowed for carving is 1 hour and 30 minutes (90 minutes).
- Setup and clean-up must be completed within this time frame.
- Participants must bring their own vegetables, carving tools, and accessories.
- No pre-cut or pre-carved items are allowed. All work must be done onsite.
- Tools like knives, peelers, carving kits, skewers, toothpicks, and cutting boards are permitted. A maximum of 4 types of vegetables can be used. If anyone is found using more than 4 types, it would result in disqualification.
- Use of thermocol, glitter, plastic, or artificial items (colours etc) is strictly prohibited.
- The theme for the carving will be announced on the day of the competition to ensure fairness.
- Designs should reflect creativity, cleanliness, and relevance to the theme.
  - Gloves and aprons are recommended.
- Sharp tools must be handled responsibly. No external assistance is allowed during the competition.
- Registration fee 200/ There will be NO on spot registration for this event. Registration has to be done from the schools (through the incharge teachers)
