Rules and Regulations:

1. SOLO SONG

- Type: Song can be classical, semi classical, western or filmy song.
- The lyrics must be memorized
- Songs can be of any language
- No accompaniment music is allowed
- Sruti box is not allowed
- Judgement criteria: Rhythm, Voice, Melody and Overall Impact
- Duration: 3+1 (After Warning) minutes only



2. SOLO DANCE (NON-CLASSICAL)

• Type: Dance form can be Western or Folk. Semi Classical dance will not be considered for the evaluation.

• Judgement criteria: Rhythm, Choreography, Synchronization and Overall Performance

• Songs must be brought in pen drives only, and must be submitted 30 minutes prior to the starting of the event. Keep a backup file

• Duration: 3+1 (After Warning) minutes only

3. SOLO DANCE (CLASSICAL)

- Type: Dance form should be Classical.
- Judgement criteria: Rhythm, Choreography, Synchronization and Overall Performance
- Songs must be brought in pen drives only, and must be submitted 30 minutes prior to the starting of the event. Keep a backup file
- Duration: 3+1 (After Warning) minutes only

Panchatantra, Fairy Tales.)

□ Participants must narrate the story (reading from paper is not allowed).

□ Voice modulation, expression, body language, and fluency will be assessed.

□ Judging Criteria:

Content & Creativity, Pronunciation & Fluency, Expression & Voice Modulation,

Confidence & Presentation

 \Box The decision of the panel of judges will be final and binding.

7. POEM RECITATION

□ Duration: 2+1 (After warning) minutes only

□ Separate Poem recitation competitions for English Medium and

Kannada Medium Schools.

□ The poem can be original or selected from well-known authors/poets.

□ Reading from a paper is not allowed; recitation must be memorized.

□ Judging Criteria: Fluency & accuracy, Pronunciation and Clarity, Voice Modulation

& Expression, Confidence & Stage Presence
